About Nagpur City BTP Study:

14% city lives beyond the pipes (BTP) in slums as per 2011 census data. Piramal Foundation plans to undertake a Need Assessment Study for identifying drinking water solutions using Hub and Spoke models. The study will be conducted by the Urban and Policy teams of Piramal in alliance with with Nagpur Municipal Corporation and an external entity.

Key Roles/Responsibilities:

- Overseeing mapping of contamination profile of drinking water sources, water quality testing, behavior change campaigns etc.
